Capilano University (CapU) is a public university based in North Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada, with programming serving the Sunshine Coast and the Sea-to-Sky corridor. It was founded in 1968 as Capilano College by school boards and residents of the North Shore and Howe Sound based on the need for a public institution serving the local communities. Capilano University's academic offerings include liberal arts, professional, and career programs which lead to certificates, diplomas, and degrees at the primarily undergraduate level.

Pathway Program Advantages

- ◆ GPA: Minimum 2.0 at VPC
- ◆ Math: Completing and passing VPC ACCT 260
