VPC

- 1. Be at least 17 years of age
- 2. Have graduated from high school (19 years of age applying as a mature student)
- 3. Provide proof of English proficiency
 - Grade 12 or higher level English course
 - High School English 12: C
 - College level English course (non-ESL): C
 - English Language Test (only valid for two years):
 - TOEFL: 68 iBT (with no individual score less than 16)
 - IELTS: 6.0 (with no band score less than 5.5)
 - VPC English Proficiency Exam: 75% (Test fee: \$25 CAD)
 - Completion of VPC English 099

- 1. Successfully graduate from VPC diploma programs
- 2. With GPA no less than 2.5

 - A copy of Study Permit (if applicable)
4. VPC will issue the following:
 - Official acknowledgement of your application
 - A receipt for the application fee
 - Student Enrollment Contract
5. Submit the appropriate fees and signed Student Enrollment Contract
6. VPC will issue an official Letter of Acceptance to apply for Study Permit
